

CONSENT

to personal data processing

When the user registers on the website for electronic invitation tickets, they accept this Consent to the processing of personal data (hereinafter – Consent). Acting freely, by their own will and in their interest as well as confirming their capacity, the User agrees to the Operator to process their personal data.

Personal Data Subject is an individual who has used the Website on the Internet and has provided the personal data to the Operator in one of the following ways: by filling in the registration form on the Website; by sending personal data to the Operator's email address indicated on the website; by communicating personal data to any Operator's phone number listed on the website.

The consent is given to the processing of my personal data, which are not special or biometric: last name, first name, patronymic (if available); phone number; email address; age; user data – location information; cookies; device type and screen layout; the source from which the user came to the website; ip address.

The purpose of personal data processing: provision of rights to use the website in order to obtain an electronic ticket to visit Opening and Closing Ceremonies of the 45th WorldSkills Competition, Kazan, Russia 2019 under the terms of the Website Terms; processing incoming requests from users to provide advice; analytics of the User's actions on the website and the functioning of the website; conducting newsletters.

The basis for the processing of the User's personal data is: clauses 1 and 5 of part 1 of article 6 of the Federal Law No. 152-FZ "On Personal Data", this Consent.

The Operator collects, records, organizes, accumulates, uses, stores, refines (updates, changes), retrieves, uses, transfers (distributes, provides, accesses), depersonalizes, blocks, deletes, destroys Personal Data. The operator performs automated processing and manual processing of personal data.

Personal data is not publicly available.

Personal data are processed until the account of an individual is deleted or at the time of receiving the request of the subject of personal data to stop processing. Consent may be revoked by the subject of personal data or their legal representative by sending a written statement to the Operator.

In the event that the subject revokes personal data or their legal representative consent to the processing of personal data, the Operator may continue to process personal data without the consent of the subject, if there are grounds specified in paragraphs 2–11 of part 1 of article 6, part 2 of article 10 and part 2 of article 11 Law No. 152-FZ "On Personal Data" dated 27 July 2006.

Upon reaching the processing objectives, the personal data provided will be destroyed.

In matters not regulated by this Agreement the Parties are guided by the Federal Law of 27 July 2006 No. 152-FZ "On Personal Data" and the Operator's Personal Data Processing Policy. Consent is an integral part of the Policy.
